

Special Effects Department

Any person accepting a call within the SPFX Department must bring a “Basic Tool Kit” with them to the call, and have it on their person or close by. A “Basic Tool Kit” contains personal supplies you need to perform the work. These are not considered part of a rental kit. The items are usually packed in a small pouch or bag worn around the waist or over the shoulder. They should be accessible at all times when working.

WHAT YOU MUST HAVE WITH YOU!

Basic Tool Kit includes:

- 10” crescent wrench,
- Second wrench,
- Channel locks,
- Multi bit driver,
- Work knife,
- Diagonal cutters,
- Flashlight and/or headlamp,
- Lighter and/or torch
- PPE (especially ears and eyes)
- ***All weather gear!***

All weather gear includes: clothing, footwear and accessories you are going to need to work in both outdoor and indoor conditions. Conditions can change quickly, so come prepared for anything!

*Please note that basic PPE (personal protective equipment) may be provided by production, but is actually the responsibility of the worker. Please do not ask other departments for such devices as it may interfere in their ability to do their work. Do not participate in work where your PPE is inadequate. Please check with your department head for more details.

Different positions within the department may have **additional** tool requirements. Check with the Department Head before the call.
